



The candidates who have accomplished the criteria of the final examination will receive a **certificate of apprenticeship of Liechtenstein as well as a report card** and they have the right to assume this legally protected occupational title.

1. LEGALLY PROTECTED TITLE

Hair Dresser / Hair Designer

2. DESCRIPTION

Hair dressers deal with the care and beautification of skin and hair. They emphasise the client's personality in an advantageous manner through advice and suitable treatment. In the beauty salon the hair dressers schedule the client's appointments. They welcome them and find out the client's wishes in a brief discussion. They determine hair type and structure and provide advice to the client regarding a suitable and modern hair style including appropriate chemical and physical hair treatments. The work starts by washing of and caring for hair and scalp. Cutting of the hair requires highly professional knowledge and creativity of the professionals. The variety of the hair styles is based on an ideal hair cut, be it according to a traditional or a top fashionable model. Perfect cutting technique with knife or scissors is crucial for shaping and sustaining the hair style. By request hair dressers carry out special treatments like dyeing, tinting, bleaching, or perming hair. This requires accurate and gentle processing as well as alertness, e.g. mixing of the colours in the "laboratory", applying, complying with the application times as well as rinsing the hair. The hair is subsequently styled with the help of a blow dryer and a round brush or comb. At the end of the treatment, the hair dressers collect the money for the check and say goodbye to the client. Services for gentlemen include chemical or physical hair treatments, shaving as well as beard and moustache care in addition to the usual services such as washing and cutting.

3. PROFILE OF PROFESSIONAL SKILLS AND QUALITIES

Those who have completed this professional training successfully will have gained competence in the following areas of study: interaction with clients, skin and hair care, hair cutting, doing perms, dyeing, hair styling, hair care for women or men. The required theoretical trade knowledge, general knowledge and personality development are mandatory classes taught at the vocational school.

4. PROSPECTIVE PROFESSIONAL FIELDS OPEN TO HOLDERS OF A HAIR DRESSER CERTIFICATE

The work area for hair dressers is mainly in individual small businesses, but also in the tourism industry as well as health or beauty parlours and hotel resorts.
